Cash and prizes are being offered to winning entries in this year's 22nd annual Spring Arts Festival. Open to all area school age children PreK-12.

PRELIMINARY COMPETITION will take place prior to the Spring Arts Festival.

Outside judges will select the top 10 entries in each of the divisions and categories. Only those entries selected during the preliminaries will advance to the festival for exhibit where the final judging for "Best of Show" and 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place winners will be announced on Saturday, April 16th.

ART CONTEST FOR KIDS: Grades K-12th March 11th Deadline to Enter

Framed entries will be allowed. All entries must be matted. Construction paper acceptable. All entries must have been completed in the last twelve months. No entries larger than 24" wide or long will be eligible. All digital art work must be printed and matted. All entries must be clearly marked on the back with the name, address, grade, school and phone number and/or email of the participant.

POETRY CONTEST: 3rd-12th grades. March 11th Deadline to Enter

\$25 cash awarded to all "Best of Show" winner in each division.

Only 3 entries per child will be accepted. All entries must be typed on a standard sheet of typing paper. No matting or framing required however gluing sheet to construction paper is acceptable. All entries must have been completed in the last twelve months. No entries larger than 24" wide or long will be eligible. All entries must be clearly marked on the back with the name, address, grade, school and phone number and/or email of the participant. Illustrations can accompany the poem as long as they are included on the single sheet of paper.
