Rules and Regulations:

1. All entries must be original and completed in the past year. *(from May 2011- present)*
2. Up to three entries per student may be submitted.
3. **No entry fee required to enter.**
4. All craftwork must include the following information on an index card secured to the entry: **Name, grade, school and phone number.**
5. Entries must be hand delivered to City ArtWorks on Main Street in downtown Minden between 3pm and 6pm on Friday, April 6th or between 9am-12N on Saturday, April 7th.
6. All winning entries will be exhibited at the Spring Arts Festival. The hours of the festival are 9am-7pm. **General Admission is \$5 for adults. Children admitted free.**
7. Ribbons for each category and each age division will be awarded for : "1st place", "2nd place", " 3rd place" and "Honorable Mention". "Best of Show winners will receive a rosette.

Art, Poetry, Yarn & Thread winners will be included in determining the "Most Talented School" contest in conjunction with the "Great Talent Search".

Students of all ages are invited to compete on stage for the ultimate prize of "Most Talented Student in Webster Parish."

How to get selected:

- Three students from each school in the parish will be invited to perform on stage during this year's Spring Arts Festival.
- Individual schools are encouraged to sponsor their own talent show with 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners advancing to the festival for the finals on Saturday, April 30th.
- NEW!! Past 1st place division winners can compete this year in the "Winner Circle" for scholarship money.
- If your school does not sponsor a talent show, open auditions will be made available prior to the festival.
Dates and times will be announced later.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Only students from Webster Parish are eligible to compete.
2. No entry fee is required. You must represent one of the public or private schools in the parish. Homeschoolers will be allowed to enter as a single school.
3. Three acts will be accepted from each participating school.
4. Your act or routine must be limited to no more than 4 minutes of stage time.
5. A sound system will be provided however you will be responsible for bringing your own music and props.
