2. All art entries must be matted on construction paper or matte board for presentation. **NO FRAMED ART!**
3. Up to three entries per student may be submitted.
4. **No entry fee required to enter.** All artwork must include the following information taped to the front, bottom portion of each entry. **Name, age, school, address and phone number.** *(Form provided at the bottom of this page.)*
5. Entries must be submitted to the principal's office at each participating school no later than **Tuesday, April 15th or** they may be hand delivered to The Children's Center at 806 Broadway St. in Minden; between 4pm and 6pm on or before Wednesday, April 16th.
6. All winning entries will be exhibited at the Spring Arts Festival. The hours of the festival are 9am-7pm. **General Admission is \$2 per person. Anyone in Chinese costume will be admitted Free of charge.**
7. Ribbons for each category and each age division will be awarded for : "1st place", "2nd place", " 3rd place" and "Honorable Mention". "Best of Show" will receive a personalized art case with art supplies valued at \$30.00.

3. Up to three poems per student may be submitted.
4. **No entry fee required to enter.** All ages must include the following information on the front, bottom portion of the poem: **Name, age, school, address and phone number.** *(Form provided at the bottom of this page.)*
5. All entries must be submitted to the principal's office at each participating school no later than **Tuesday, April 8th.** All entries will be returned to the school following the festival or picked up at the festival following the awards ceremony on Saturday, April 26th at 6pm.
6. All winning entries will be exhibited at the Spring Arts Festival. The hours of the festival are 9am-7pm. **General Admission is \$2 per person. Anyone in Chinese costume will be admitted Free of charge.**
7. Ribbons for each category and each age division will be awarded for : "1st place", "2nd place", " 3rd place" and "Honorable Mention". "Best of Show" winners will receive a personalized Poet's Journal and pen.
